Why oh why?

...or “what is the point of your project”?

Do you have an “elevator pitch”?

- 1 Why should anyone else care?
- 2 What problem does it solve?
- 3 What interesting results are there?

What is the *scope* of your project?

- What should be complete and working well as part of the “core” project?
- Are particular issues specifically “out of scope”?
- What are nice “extras” that are “easy” wins?
- What could someone do to extend your project in future?

Justify yourself!

- *Why* did you choose that/those language(s)?
- *Why* that database, IDE and/or framework?
- *Why* did you choose that platform / cloud environment?

What is exciting?

- ① What's great about your project?
- ② What will make an interviewer take interest?
- ③ What was challenging? How did you solve those challenges?

But remember LSEPI

- **L** legal,
- **S** social,
- **E** ethical, and
- **P** professional

issues

- Did your project have any issues to address? If so, how?
- If someone deployed your project, what issues would need addressing? How could they be addressed?

- What assumptions have you made?
- What personal data does your project process? What other data is processed?
- Is your project free of security issues?
 - How do you know it's free of issues...?
- What controls would be required to deploy your project? (Why?!)
